



Overseas Requirements for a Visa to Belize

Please note that all documents MUST be submitted in English and must undergo a visa vetting process. Therefore, the processing of visas could take 3 to 4 weeks, with this in mind please allow ample time to make your travel plans.

The following procedures are to be followed in forwarding an application to the Belize High Commission in London:

- 1. Completed application form**
- 2. Your Passport** with at least 6 months validity of the length of time of you travel
- 3. 1 recent passport-sized photographs** measuring 2 inches x 2 inches
- 4. Proof of Travel Arrangements:** valid flight booking and travel itinerary
- 5. Proof of Accommodation:** hotel confirmation or full contact details of host in Belize
- 6. Proof of Financial Means:** copies of most recent bank statements, or if you are travelling for business a letter from your Financial Officer
- 7. Travel Insurance**
- 8. Letter of Reference from employer or current educational establishment**
- 9. Letter of Invitation from host:** family and friends in Belize must show clear connection with applicant and include a copy of their passport or Social Security Card, or for business and official visits a letter of invitation on headed paper from host is required
- 10. Fee:** the application fee is non-refundable payable in cash, Banker's Draft or an International Money Order made payable to, 'Belize High Commission'. In ***general a single entry visa fee is £60 and a multiple entry visa fee is £110.00. Statutory Instrument #42 of 2005 - Section 4(2) provides a variation in fees for some nationals including holders of Diplomatic & Official passports.***

In some cases there are countries that may require clearance from Belize. It should be further noted that due to the recent changes made in SI # 32 of 2011, any foreign national requiring visa clearance and holding a valid US multiple entry visa or a valid US Permanent Residency Card may be issued a visa for Belize with due consideration from the Department of Immigration and Nationality. The fee applicable in these cases is £60 single entry and £110.00 multiple entry, regardless of nationality. Persons requiring visa clearance and not in possession of US Visas or US Permanent Residency are still subject to referral to the Department of Immigration and Nationality. The associated fee as indicated on the visa requirements list.
